About Program:

Innovedica Foundation has been a committed platform for fostering developmental activities aimed at ensuring sustainable progress for the last person in society. The Youth for Swaraj initiative is a meaningful endeavour to revive and activate the philosophy of Mahatma Gandhi among today's youth and civil society organisations. It encourages deeper reflection and collective action toward the upliftment of common people, inspired by the spirit of Gandhian Vinoba Bhave and Ram Manohar Lohia's thoughts.

With a focus on skilling the youth, spreading peace and harmony, and promoting health-centric self-governance (Swasthya Swaraj), Innovedica Foundation has embarked on this historic journey.

Vision: The vision of the Innovedica Youth for Swaraj programme is to foster ecological democracy (Harit Swaraj), inspired by the Vedic principles of Sanatan Dharma and Gandhian principles, promoting a system rooted in ecological harmony and sustainability.

The Goal is to create a self-reliant system where communities live harmoniously with nature, practising sustainability, decentralisation, and self-sufficiency.

According to the Vedas, the basic gross elements or Pancha Mahabhoota of Nature represent a close connection between ecology and its surrounding democracy, which is known as *Ecological Democracy/Harit Swaraj*.

This term was coined by Shri Vijay Pratap and Shri Anupam Mishra ji during the first decade of the 21st century.

The inaugural day of the Youth4Swaraj Odisha Chapter commenced on **September 5, 2025**, marked by an Inauguration Ceremony at the Gandhi Labour Foundation, Puri. Under the guidance of the Cultural Committee members, **Ms. Kalpana Sahoo** and **Ms. Arpita Mishra**, the morning began with the arrival and assembly of participants, creating an atmosphere of energy and anticipation.







The program opened with a welcome address by Ms Nazmin Saikia, Ms. Kalpana Sahoo, and Ms. Arpita Mishra, setting the tone for a day of purpose and unity. This was followed by the lamp lighting ceremony, conducted by eminent dignitaries including Hem Bhai, Swami Ji, and Shri Madhu Bhai, along with Innovedica's leadership team. The ceremony was enriched with Ved Mantra chanting by Ms. Prabhasini Ji (Abhiyan), and floral tributes were offered to Lord Jagannath and to

the portrait of **Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan**, in honour of Teachers' Day.

The inaugural addresses began with a **speech by Ms. Farhat Jahan**, who highlighted the life and contributions of Dr. Radhakrishnan. This was followed by inspirational words from **Shri**

Madhu Bhai and Shri Jagadananda Ji, who urged the youth to embrace their role in shaping a sustainable and inclusive India.

Speaking on the occasion, Guest of the Day, Shri Jagadananda Ji, who demitted the office as the State Information Commissioner of Odisha in August 2013 to advance the Right to Information (RTI) agenda and also served as a Member of the State Planning Board of Odisha after years of campaigning for people-centric decentralized planning,



emphasized "development with the minds of the youth." He urged young people to lead the nation's journey towards **innovation and inclusiveness**, outlining the **Rebuild India Vision** that imagines a stronger, greener, and more equitable India over the next 20 years.



The first major highlight of the day was the launch of "Green Features Magazine: THINK GREEN", unveiled by a red-ribbon ceremony. The editorial team—comprising Ms. Nazmin, Ms. Arpita, Ms. Kalpana, Shri John Sir, and Shri Anthony Das—explained the vision of the magazine as a platform for promoting youth-led climate awareness and sustainable living.



The second Guest of the Day, Shri U.N. Behera Ji, a retired IAS officer who took oath as the Chairman of Odisha Electricity Regulatory Commission (OERC), delivered an inspiring address on leadership and nation-building. He stressed the importance of values-driven leadership in realising the Rebuild India @ 2047 mission, noting that ethical and inclusive governance is the key to sustainable national progress.





This was followed by the launch of the Solar Module & Harit Urja Shala (Solar Training Lab) by Dr. Azaj Khan, Director & CEO, Brother Technical Group of India. A testimonial-based presentation by Ms. Nazmin Saikia showcased real-life insights into solar innovations. The session then transitioned into discussions on the Rebuild India @

2047 movement, with Shri Vikas Arora presenting a vision briefing and leaders from different regions sharing action plans: Hem Bhai & Swami Ji for the Northeast, Shri Madhu Bhai for

Odisha, and **Shri Anthony Das** for West Bengal.

A tribute to Shri Anupam Mishra Ji was delivered by the cultural committee, led by Ms. Kalpana Sahoo and Ms. Arpita Mishra. During this session, two upcoming national seminars were announced: the National Seminar on Social Entrepreneurship, Livelihood & Inclusiveness (June 5, 2026) and the National Seminar on Rebuild India @ 2047 (November 26, 2025).





The morning concluded with **cultural performances** that reflected the spirit of unity and patriotism: *Rebuild Odisha* by Shri Madhu Bhai and the Abhiyan team, *Har Vesh Me Tu* by the Innovedica team, *Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam* by Shri Rohit Ji and Shri Neeraj Ji, and the patriotic finale *Ek Dulāra Desh Hamāra*, *Pyārā Hindustān*.



Spiritual & Cultural Immersion

Post-dinner, the group set out on **spiritual and cultural visits**, beginning with the **Jagannath Temple in Puri**, where participants offered prayers and reflected on Odisha's timeless traditions.

Day Two of the Youth4Swaraj Odisha Chapter began with a refreshing **Yuva Geet** and **morning yoga session**, setting an energetic rhythm for the day. The participants, full of spirit, assembled by the **Bay of Bengal shore** for the day's *Shram Sanskar* activity.

Shram Sanskar: Coastal Clean-Up & Climate Pledge

With placards in hand and voices echoing slogans of climate justice, the youth engaged in a mass coastal clean-up drive. What made this initiative unique was the use of repurposed oil tins painted blue, installed as makeshift bins to encourage a cleaner shoreline—an innovation reflecting sustainability in action.

Standing by the sea, the youth took a **Climate Pledge**, committing themselves to protect the coasts and environment. The



sound of the waves and the united voices of young people created a powerful atmosphere of responsibility and hope. A **group discussion circle** followed, where participants exchanged ideas on *sustainable practices, eco-tourism, and renewable energy solutions* for coastal livelihoods.

Taal Arpan: The Cultural Showcase

The highlight of the evening was the **grand cultural celebration** – **Taal Arpan**, curated by **Ms. Kalpana Sahoo** and **Ms. Arpita Mishra**, and anchored by **Ms. Nazmin Saikia**. The program began with a ceremonial lamp lighting and unfolded into a tapestry of performances:

- Odissi Recital by Ms. Kalpana Sahoo graceful and deeply moving.
- **Semi-Classical Dance** by Ms. Arpita Mishra blending tradition with elegance.
- **Dalkhai Folk Dance** by Akash Kumar, Subhasmita, Bhagyalaxmi & Subhalaxmi vibrant and spirited.
- **Group Odissi (Dasha Avatar)** by youth dancers under Ms. Aparna Panda narrating the ten incarnations of Lord Vishnu.
- **Devadasi Performance** by children from the Gandhi Foundation preserving Odisha's ancient heritage.
- **Bhajan "Kalia Heijiba Kale Tikie Gora"** by Sonali, Saanvi, Priyanshi, Shreepada, Chitralekha, Prasadini & Priyanshi evoking devotion and peace.

Cross-regional dances— Bharatanatyam from South India, and Odissi from Odisha—added diversity and showcased India's cultural unity.



The evening concluded with the rousing patriotic performance "Bharat Ki Santan," led by Shri Madhu Bhai, filling the hall with national pride. Certificates were distributed to all participants, with soloists receiving special recognition.

The third and final day of the Youth4Swaraj Odisha Chapter was designed as a journey into the soul of Odisha's heritage and traditions, while also creating a space for the youth to reflect on their learnings and commit themselves to the ideals of Swaraj.



Morning Session: Raghurajpur – A Heritage Awakening

The day began with a warm breakfast at Raghurajpur, the renowned craft and heritage village. As the youth settled in, they were welcomed with a Gotipua dance performance, an ancient Odishan tradition performed by young artists that combined grace, rhythm, and storytelling. The performance was a captivating introduction to the day, symbolising Odisha's living culture.



Afterwards, the participants explored the village lanes of Raghurajpur, interacting with local artisans and observing Pattachitra paintings, palm-leaf engravings, and other traditional crafts. The experience was not only artistic but also deeply reflective of how heritage and livelihoods intertwine in sustaining communities.





Afternoon Session: Pipli & Utkal Amrita

Post-lunch, the group travelled to Pipli, Puri, famous for its Chandua appliqué work associated with Lord Jagannath. Participants admired handmade bags, umbrellas, carpets, and decorative crafts, each reflecting the cultural vibrancy of Odisha.



The cultural trail then led to the Utkal Amrita Showroom in Bhubaneswar, managed by sisters Ms. Anita and Ms. Amrita. Ms. Amrita—widely recognised for her participation in *Kaun Banega Crorepati (KBC)*—personally guided the youth through Odisha's textile legacy. The participants witnessed weaving traditions and exquisite fabrics, including Sambalpuri Ikat, Bomkai, Pasapali,



Nuapatna, Berhampur Patta, Gopalpur Tassar Silk, Dongria, Bichitrapuri, and Kotpad. This session provided an inspiring glimpse into how culture sustains livelihoods while preserving identity.



Evening Session: Dialogue & Felicitation at Kalinga Stadium

In the evening, the participants gathered at Kalinga Stadium, Bhubaneswar, for an interactive dialogue on education, entrepreneurship, and youth empowerment. They were honored by the presence of Shri Mohan Charan Majhi, Hon'ble Minister of State for Higher Education, Sports and Youth Services, and Odia Language, Literature & Culture, who addressed the gathering with encouragement and vision.

Other dignitaries present included Shri Deepak Malviya, Shri Suraj Sooryavanshi, Shri Vikas Arora, and Shri Madhusudan Das, each sharing reflections on youth leadership and sustainable nation-building. Guests were honoured with Pattachitra mementoes, shawls, and bouquets as tokens of gratitude.







Special recognition was given to Rupali Hati, Farhat Jahan, Suryakant Sethi, Kalpana Sahoo, and Arpita Mishra for their contributions. In a moving gesture, Shri Madhusudan Das (Secretary, Abhiyan) presented Jagannath idols to all state directors, while Innovedica Foundation team members were gifted special idols by Madhu Bhai, symbolising blessings from Odisha's spiritual heritage.

Closing Circle & Departure

The day closed with a group reflection circle, where participants shared personal learnings, cultural insights, and commitments to carry forward the Youth4Swaraj vision in their respective communities. A joyful group photograph and farewell dinner marked the conclusion of the Odisha chapter.
